This service does not include any services or merchandise other than those listed.

Payment is expected **IN FULL** at the arrangements conference when merchandise and services are selected. For your convenience, we accept the following: Visa, Mastercard, Personal check, Money Order, Cash **- OR - Valid Assignment of Insurance Proceeds -** However, the insurance proceeds must be enough to cover the cost of services and merchandise selected. Insurance assignments are paid by the insurance company, as a courtesy, to the funeral home. The insurance company is not legally bound to pay the funeral home, therefore the family is still responsible for the balance of the funeral bill. Insurance assignments will not be accepted as payment until the insurance company has been notified and has verified that the policy is in force and will accept an assignment to the funeral home. Not all insurance companies accept assignments.
