However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide, describing the goods and services you selected.*

*The General Price List is a requirement of every mortuary and/or funeral home, by the Federal Trade Commission. When required, this information is provided to you in specific format and wording under the guidelines of the Federal Trade Commission.*

**Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and overhead.....\$ 1950.00**

This is the basic charge to each family we serve, for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities, and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this charge is the consultation with family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, assistance with insurance papers, planning the funeral or memorial service, and placement of obituary notices. There will be additional charges for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for Direct Cremation, Immediate Burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.

**Embalming.....\$ 895.00**

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates health hazards. A person licensed by the state must complete this procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as Direct Cremation or Immediate Burial.

**Forwarding of Remains to another Funeral Home or Mortuary.....\$ 2,675.00**

This service includes the basic services of Funeral Director, staff, administrative staff, and use of basic facilities, obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the transfer, transferring the deceased from the local place of death to the mortuary, within a 20 mile radius, embalming and/or sanitary care of the remains, air tray for non-casketed remains, transportation to Jacksonville International Airport.

**Receiving of Remains from another Funeral Home/Mortuary.....\$ 1250.00**

This service includes the basic services of the Funeral Director and Staff, the administrative staff, transportation from Jacksonville International Airport, to the local cemetery or crematory. This service does not include services or merchandise.

**Immediate Burial.....\$ 1865.00**

This service includes: reduced basic services of Funeral Director, staff, and overhead, removal of remains from local place of death to the funeral home, sanitary care of non-embalmed remains, casketing, transportation to cemetery within 25 miles. This service does not include: except as specifically noted above, other preparation of the deceased, visitation or funeral ceremony, merchandise, automotive equipment, cemetery costs, obituaries, or sales taxes.

**Body Donation to Medical College or other Body Donation facility.....\$ 575.00**

This service includes: reduced basic services of Funeral Director, Staff, administrative staff, removal of deceased from local place of death, obtaining information used in securing death certificates, permits, obituaries. This service does not include any services or merchandise other than those listed.

**Direct Cremation.....\$ 1795.00**

This service includes the following: Reduced Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff for obtaining information and filing legal documents, removal of deceased from local place of death to the funeral home within a 25 mile radius, sanitary care of the remains, transportation of the deceased to the crematory, alternative container (fiberboard) for cremation, cremation, temporary urn.

Payment is expected **IN FULL** at the arrangements conference when merchandise and services are selected. For your convenience, we accept the following: Visa, Mastercard, Personal check, Money Order, Cash - **OR - Valid Assignment of Insurance Proceeds** - However, the insurance proceeds must be enough to cover the cost of services and merchandise selected. Insurance assignments are paid by the insurance company, as a courtesy, to the funeral home. The insurance company is not legally bound to pay the funeral home, therefore the family is still responsible for the balance of the funeral bill. Insurance assignments will not be accepted as payment until the insurance company has been notified and has verified that the policy is in force and will accept an assignment to the funeral home. Not all insurance companies accept assignments.

**Any arrangements made with your cemetery, such as purchases of grave spaces, merchandise, or professional service fees, etc., will need to be paid directly to the cemetery.**
