

Cremation Packages

Simple Cremation \$2,695

Reduced basic services of staff (to include an arrangement conference with the family to gather vital statistics for filing the death certificate and also survivor and service information), local transfer of remains, cremation charge, securing necessary permits and authorizations, preparing and placing of unpaid or paid* obituary notices in newspapers or on our web site, basic cremation container and basic holding container.

Simple Cremation with Memorial Directing \$3,995

Simple cremation plus the services of a funeral professional directing the memorial service at another facility. Carved wood urn and basic register book package.

Cremation with A Memorial Service or Visitation \$4,295

Reduced basic services of staff (to include an arrangement conference with the family to gather vital statistics for filing the death certificate and also survivor and service information), local transfer of remains, cremation charge, securing necessary permits and authorizations, preparing and placing of unpaid or paid* obituary notices in newspapers or on our web site, 2 hours of visitation at the funeral home (prior to the memorial service) to receive family and friends, memorial service in our chapel***, basic register book package (includes register book, memorial folders, and thank you cards), basic cremation container and wooden carved urn**.

Cremation With A Viewing and Funeral Ceremony \$7,595

Basic services of staff (to include an arrangement conference with the family to gather vital statistics for filing the death certificate and also survivor and service information), local transfer of remains, embalming, dressing, casketing, and cosmetology, cremation charge, securing necessary permits and authorizations, preparing and placing of unpaid or paid* obituary notices in newspapers or on our web site, visitation at the funeral home (4 hour maximum), funeral ceremony in our chapel, use of the rental casket, basic register book package, basic cremation container, and wooden carved urn**. You may deduct \$500 from the package price if no funeral service is desired.

**If an urn upgrade is desired a \$185.00 credit will apply toward the upgraded urn.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire.

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services.

Basic services of the funeral director and staff \$2,695

Our charge includes: funeral counseling, necessary arrangements, recording vital statistics, securing permits, filing and obtaining death certificates and other forms and claims, preparation of necessary notices, and coordination of service plans with parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased. This charge also includes the cost of our building facilities that are not a part of visitation or funeral ceremony, but necessary for the conduct of business such as administrative offices, restrooms, garage, and storage of equipment, parking facilities and others. This charge also includes property taxes and insurance, utilities and telephones, legal and accounting fees, furniture, fixtures, and inventory cost as well as other administrative expenses. And of course, it covers the expense of being available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

Embalming. \$1,350

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Embalming is a chemical process that provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Sanitary preparation of the deceased is part of the embalming process. This procedure must be completed by a funeral professional licensed by this state.

This charge includes local removal of remains, reduced basic services of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, and local transportation to common carrier (but not shipping charges, or staff for visitation or funeral service).

Our charges for an immediate burial includes local removal of remains, sanitary care of remains, reduced basic services of staff, authorizations and casket coach to local cemetery.

Graveside with Private Family Viewing. \$5,500

Our charges for a graveside service with family viewing includes local removal of remains, embalming, dressing, casketing, cosmetology, private family visitation, reduced basic services of staff, authorizations and casket coach to local cemetery.

Traditional Burial Package (same day). \$6,495

The itemized charges included in our traditional burial package are: basic services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, embalming, dressing, casketing, cosmetology, use of staff and facilities for a same day visitation, use of staff and facilities for a funeral service conducted in our chapel or another location, casket coach (hearse), and service/utility vehicles

Traditional Burial Package \$6,995

The itemized charges included in our traditional burial package are: basic services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, embalming, dressing, casketing, cosmetology, use of staff and facilities for a visitation, use of staff and facilities for a funeral service conducted in our chapel or another location, casket coach (hearse), procession fee
