The goods and services shown below are those we can provide for families. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

**Basic Services**

**OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR & STAFF.....\$3,500**

Our fee for the services of Funeral Director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff assistance in local removal from place of death; arrangement conference and consultation with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral or memorial services, including supervising of all arrangements pertaining to the service, direction of and assistance of the funeral procession to the place of final disposition and coordination of burial committal service; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits, and recording vital statistics; placement of death and funeral notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the services, including coordination with those providing other portions of the service (e.g. cemetery, crematory, Veterans Affairs and others). Also included in these charges are overhead expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses. **This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to selected funeral arrangements.**

**Embalming .....\$800**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not choose embalming, you usually have the right to select an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

**Other Preparation of Body ..... \$400**

This fee includes disinfection, shaving, trimming mustaches and beards, men's haircut and basic women's hairstyling, cosmetology, dressing and casketing of remains.

*(Minimum Care)* ..... \$300
- Special procedure in autopsy cases ..... \$100
- Special procedure in organ/tissue donations ..... \$150
- Dyes or Tints ..... \$ 50
- Reconstruction / Restoration *(per hour)*.....\$125
- Removal of implanted devices  
 such as pacemakers *(Cremation)* .....\$150

**Graveside Ceremony Package ..... \$4,995**

This service includes professional services, transfer of remains, embalming, other body preparations, use of facilities for viewing, and hearse.

**Cremation with memorial service**

**Off-Site Location.....\$1,695**

This service includes professional service fee, staff supervision, set-up of location, and cremation.

**The Chapel..... \$1,595**

This service includes professional service fee, staff supervision, use of chapel and cremation.

**Direct cremation**

**w/private family viewing.....\$1,295**

We offer alternative containers and cremation caskets. Alternative containers in case the body and can be made of materials like fiber board and composition materials.

**DIRECT CREMATION.....\$695**

Service provided includes, but is not limited to, removal of remains, necessary authorizations, transfer to the crematory, a basic urn and cremation casket. COVID-19 remains are \$995.

**Cremation following a traditional funeral ..... \$500**

**Immediate burial services.....\$1,000 to \$1,200**

This service includes professional services, transfer of remains, temporary shelter of remains, local transportation to cemetery, preparation and filing of necessary authorizations. This service does not include any rites or ceremonies.

With minimum casket ..... \$2,000
