
#### BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

The fee for the services of the funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, to respond to the initial request for service;
- Arrangements conference with the family or responsible party;
- Arrangements of the funeral;
- Preparation and filing of necessary authorization and permits;
- Recording of vital statistics;
- Preparation and placement of obituary newspaper notices;
- Assistance prior to, during and following the funeral including coordination with those

- Overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance/utility expenses, secretarial administrative cost, and equipment and inventory cost.







EMBALMING \$995.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant, rites, or ceremonies includes removal of remains, necessary services of staff for authorizations and cremation charge. Our crematory requires the human remains be placed in a minimum alternative cremation container to enable us to place the remains in to cremation chamber for cremation. Alternative containers encase the remains and can be made of materials like heavy corrugated cardboard, fiberboard or composition materials. Plus one cremation urn with no viewing of remains.

All containers provided must meet any applicable state or crematory requirements.

- Direct Cremation with private family viewing (Within 48 hours) \$2,145.00 AND UP

  All services included in direct cremation, as well as the bathing of the deceased, and 1 hour family viewing. This includes a container for viewing. (Non-embalmed remains plus a cremation urn)
