#### CARE OF THE DECEASED

EMBALMING \$600.00

Embalming is a chemical process that provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Sanitary preparation of the deceased is part of the embalming process. This procedure must be completed by a Georgia licensed embalmer.

Except in certain cases, <u>embalming is not required by law</u>. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing and/or a public visitation. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

#### **CREMATION PROCESS**

The casket or cremation container is carried to a crematory where it is placed in a cremation chamber which is heated to an extremely high temperature. The intense heat reduces the casket or cremation container, as well as the remains, to small bone fragments which are then placed in a processor and reduced in size. The cremated remains are then placed in an urn or temporary container and returned to the family.
