7. Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home

This charge includes: Transportation of remains from Atlanta Airport to our Facility, basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, necessary permits and Authorizations, and transportation of remains to a local cemetery.

This charge does not include: any merchandise, rites or ceremonies, cemetery equipment or charges, paid obit notices, or any other cash advance items.

8. Direct Cremation from \$ 1,895.00

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container instead of a casket. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like cardboard, fiberboard, or composition materials, with or without an outside covering. The containers we provide are: Basic Cardboard Cremation Container, Cloth Covered Wood Casket, or and hardwood Casket. Note: Crematory does require that the body be in some kind of a container)

These charges include: Transfer of remains from place of death to crematory, basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, necessary permits and authorizations. Ashes are returned from the crematory in a temporary, plastic container .

These prices are effective as of September 1, 2017, but are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our clients. You may choose only those items you desire. Any Funeral Arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the Statement we provide describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected.

1. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$ 1295.00*

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.) Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to the initial request for services; arrangement conference with family and/or responsible parties; arrangement of the funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e. g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies, and others as required. In addition, this fee includes a proportional share of overhead expenses relative to our staff and facilities such as professional licensing and continuing education, legal and accounting fees, insurances, building and utility expenses, parking area and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, secretarial and administrative expenses, and compliance with infectious waste management and employee safety regulations mandated by governmental agencies.

2. Embalming \$ 695.00*

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with public viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.
