GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective January 1, 2019 but are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangement you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$2,350.00

Our charge includes, but is not limited to, consultations with the family or other responsible parties; staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service; coordinating funeral service plans with the cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties; preparing and securing death certificates and other official documents; placing obituary notices; responding to other needs and desires of the family and friends; and other overhead expenses such as licensing, taxes, insurance, accounting and administration. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charge for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING \$ 765.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Beyond 50 miles, add \$2.25 per mile one way. Includes 3 hours; add \$40 per hour thereafter.

SERVICE CAR WITHIN RADIUS OF 50 MILES..... \$ 265.00

Beyond 50 miles, add \$2.25 per mile one way.

ADULT CASKETS..... \$ 860.00 to \$ 9290.00

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$2,210.00
 This charge includes transfer of remains to funeral home, embalming, basic services of funeral director and staff, necessary authorizations and transportation to the Jacksonville, FL airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body. Merchandise would be added to this amount.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$1,410.00
 This charge includes basic services of staff, temporary shelter of remains, and transportation of remains to the cemetery. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies, or transfer of remains to funeral home.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL.....\$2,160.00 to \$ 3020.00
 Our charge for an immediate burial without any attendant rites or ceremonies including transfer of deceased to funeral home, basic services of funeral director and staff, and service car to transport to cemetery. No cemetery or other charges included in this total.

DIRECT CREMATION.....\$2,845.00 to \$5,850.00
 Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies include transfer of deceased to funeral home, basic services of funeral director and staff, preparation of the deceased, and cremation fee by crematory of our choice. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering.) Merchandise would be added to this amount.

CHOICES RELATED TO PAYMENT

Since 1936 McLane Funeral Services has provided compassionate and professional funeral services for the families who have chosen us in their time of need. As part of our tradition of caring and concern for those we serve, we want to offer you several choices for the method of payment of your account. If you have questions or concerns please talk with your arranging funeral director.

1. **Third Party Expense Items** – Payment for cemetery fees, newspaper obituaries, certified copies of death certificates, honorariums or other third party expenses will be expected in the form of a check or cash before the funeral service because these parties are paid when their service is provided.
2. **Funeral Account** – We are a family-operated small business, providing service and merchandise and are dependent upon our clients for prompt payment. It is essential for all parties that a clear understanding about method of payment is reached during the arrangement conference.
 - A. Payment may be made in cash, personal check, bank check, money order, Visa, MasterCard or Discover. Payments received by cash or check by service time will receive a cash discount. The cash discount is not available on payments made by credit card.
 - B. Assignment of proceeds from verified life insurance may be accepted to pay the funeral account. Proceeds in excess of the amount of the funeral account will be paid directly to the named beneficiary.
 - C. Funded pre-arranged funeral plans
 - D. In cases where the deceased's estate must stand the burden of paying the funeral expenses, we ask that family representatives pay the funeral expenses and file claim for reimbursement with the deceased estate.
 - E. In all cases where total payment has not been received as agreed, late payment penalties (18% APR) and legal fees incurred in the collection process must be paid by the family representative(s) authorizing the Statement of Goods and Services.

The terms you choose will be documented on your Statement of Goods and Services and will represent the method by which you agree to settle your account with Carson McLane, Inc. and McLane Funeral Services.

SERVICE A – TRADITIONAL MEMORIAL SERVICE AT CHURCH

- Full arrangements conference, general staff services, and general overhead
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body including embalming.
- One day visitation or gathering at the funeral home on day prior to service.
- A funeral director and other staff assist at church with register book, parking, seating, arranging and listing flowers and coordination of other details and participants.
- Automotive equipment for transportation of casket and flowers to church.

SERVICE B – TRADITIONAL MEMORIAL SERVICE IN CHAPEL

- Full arrangement conference, general staff services and general overhead.
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body including embalming.
- One day visitation or gathering at the funeral home on day prior to service.
- A funeral director and other staff assist at funeral home with register book, parking, seating, arranging and listing flowers and coordination of other details and participants.

SERVICE C – MEMORIAL SERVICE WITH LIMITED VISITATION IN CHAPEL

- Full arrangement conference, general staff services and general overhead.
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body including embalming.
- Visitation is scheduled for one hour immediately prior to memorial service.
- A funeral director and other staff assist at funeral home with register book, parking, seating, arranging and listing flowers and coordination of other details and participants.
- Automotive equipment cost is reduced because there is no hearse to the church.

SERVICE D – LIMITED MEMORIAL SERVICE IN CHAPEL

- Limited arrangement conference, general staff services and general overhead.
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body without embalming.
- Visitation is scheduled for one hour immediately prior to memorial service with urn present.
- A funeral director and staff assists with register book, parking, seating and other details.

SERVICE E – LIMITED MEMORIAL SERVICE IN CHURCH

- Limited arrangement conference, general staff services and general overhead.
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body without embalming.
- Family may receive friends for up to one hour immediately prior to memorial service with urn present.
- A funeral director and staff assists with register book, parking, seating and other details.

SERVICE F – DIRECT CREMATION

- Brief arrangement conference, general staff services and general overhead.
- Transfer to funeral home and care of the body without embalming.
