To lose someone you love is a devastating human experience. It is frequently traumatic and can seriously impact judgment. We believe in the importance of the recognition and meaningful celebration of a life that has been lived and will assist in arranging an appropriate service to meet your individual needs. It is also important to be realistic in respect to funeral expenditures. We do not want a family to spend more than they should, nor less than they would like. What is important is that the arrangement be in keeping with a family's wishes and budget.

PAYMENT POLICY

Provisions for payment are due at the time of the arrangements. To avoid any possibility of misunderstanding or embarrassment, and for your convenience, we accept the following methods of payment: CASH, CHECK, or CREDIT CARD (VISA, MASTERCARD, or DISCOVER), or PRE-PAID funeral agreements. Insurance policies are only accepted when approved and processed by a funeral funding company and the processing fee is paid by the person (or persons) acting as the responsible party (or parties). For those families opting to pay by check, cash or credit card, we will assist in filing insurance claims for the named beneficiary. We can NO LONGER wait for estates to be settled or probated and the person or persons making arrangements is responsible for payment.

CASH ADVANCE ITEMS

Cash Advances are to be paid at the time of the arrangements.

These are items that we will pay on your behalf. These are just a few examples of Cash Advance Items. There are many more that could relate to the services you select

UNDERSTANDING FUNERAL COSTS......

It is your legal right, and our desire, that you have a complete understanding of our funeral service costs. The funeral director helps the family to better accept death, and lays the groundwork for healthy bereavement. The tradition of taking a traumatic situation and molding it into a meaningful service of remembrance is an important part of our social structure, and of personal health, both mental and physical. That's why the funeral director's knowledge and experience is so helpful to those who mourn. In order to serve the needs of every family, the funeral director must maintain a professional staff and adequate funeral home facilities. The funeral director is also faced with other operating expenses which are demanded of a service oriented business. A brief description of these and other costs are as follows:

PROPERTY

The land on which the building and parking facilities are located must be adequate in size to accommodate demand during the visitation and funeral service. Owning such property, in a convenient and accessible location, constitutes one of the major ongoing costs of the funeral home operation.

FACILITIES

A funeral home is decorated and furnished to provide a homelike comfortable atmosphere easily adaptable to visitation and the funeral service. The facility must be adequately designed to accommodate more than one family at a given time, built to local codes and meet federal requirements such as ADA.

AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT

The funeral director must provide appropriate automotive equipment for use in properly performing services for the families they serve. Owning and maintaining this equipment, much of which is specifically designed, is quite costly.

FUNERAL RESOURCE CENTER

In the Funeral Resource Center, you will find a wide variety of merchandise; caskets, vaults, clothing, register books, memorial folders, thank you cards, keepsakes, cremation urns, stationery, and many other items, which are made available by the funeral director. Providing these many items requires considerable space and investment in inventory.

A PROFESSIONAL STAFF

Salaries and benefits make up the largest part of the funeral expense. Personnel are chosen carefully to assure that families receive professional and efficient service. To attract qualified personnel, funeral homes must compete with salaries and benefits paid by other professions, businesses and industries.

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Funeral Directors and Embalmers are required by law to meet certain academic standards. Georgia funeral directors and embalmers are required to graduate from a certified mortuary college and pass an examination administrated by the State Board of Funeral Service prior to being issued a license to practice. To maintain this license, they are required to obtain continuing education annually in order to improve their knowledge and skills. Only licensed funeral directors and embalmers are permitted to practice within the State of Georgia. This highly specialized training prepares each funeral service professional to offer appropriate service to bereaved families.

DOCUMENTS AND DEATH BENEFITS

A number of documents must be processed at the time of death. The funeral director prepares these many forms and assists the families in following the correct procedures in collecting various benefits.

TAXES AND INSURANCE

The funeral director, as a business person, operates a taxable enterprise. The business is assessed a considerable amount of property, ad valorem and income tax each year. The insurance premiums are sizable because of the service oriented business we provide. These premiums also protect the investment of the property, facilities and automotive equipment.

24 - HOUR AVAILABILITY

The funeral home is available to serve families 24 hours per day. This means that the telephone is attended and personnel are available to assist those who have experienced a death regardless of the day or hour. We are pleased to assist you in every way possible. We appreciate your confidence, and trust that our service is comforting in every way. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our client families. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

SERVICES

Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$2995.00

This is the basic charge to each family we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with clergy, cemetery, common carrier, and planning of the funeral service. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming \$795.00

Embalming is a surgical procedure which uses a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by the State of Georgia must complete this procedure.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

Forwarding Remains to another Funeral Home.....\$2,995.00

This charge includes basic professional services of the funeral director and staff, removal and transfer of the deceased to the funeral home, embalming, transportation to the Atlanta airport. This charge applies to shipment within the continental United States <u>only</u>. An additional administrative and storage fee of \$1500.00 will be added to shipment outside the Continental United States. Certain types of merchandise (casket, shipping container, etc) may be required by the country into which the remains are shipped, you will be informed of those requirements. Airlines require the remains shipped within the continental United States to be encased in a disposable shipping unit when a permanent casket is not selected for shipment. The charge for this unit is \$225.00. If you choose a permanent casket for shipping, the airlines require the casket be placed in an approved shipping tray for protection of the casket and remains. The charge for this unit is \$175.00 for those used within the continental United States.

This service does not include: Cash advance items, common carrier charges (airfare), taxes or additional services.

Receiving Remains from another Funeral Home.....\$2,995.00

This charge includes basic professional services of the funeral director and staff, transportation from the Atlanta Airport, and hearse service to the cemetery. This price reflects a package discount and applies only to the services rendered in THIS package.

This service does not include: Cash advance items, other funeral home charges, common carrier charges (airfare), taxes or additional charges.

A SERVICE FEE CHARGED BY THE VAULT COMPANY FOR DELIVERY, EQUIPMENT AND STAFF TO SET-UP AND SERVICE THE OUTER BURIAL CONTAINER WILL BE ADDED TO EACH BURIAL CONTAINER PURCHASED. THIS CHARGE (\$475.00 / \$1,070.00 ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS) WILL APPEAR IN THE CASH ADVANCE AREA OF YOUR FINAL STATEMENT.

**Please note that in certain cemeteries, outside vault companies are not allowed to service their outer burial containers. These cemeteries require that only their cemetery staff set up and service any outer burial container used in that cemetery. The vault company service charge will cover the fees within reasonable limits. If the fee by the cemetery is beyond the normal amount charged by the vault company, you will be informed.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Many families have very little experience when it comes to handling the arrangements of a loved one who has died. The following are some common questions families ask. We hope you will find these questions and answers helpful.

1. What is an honorarium, who receives one and what amount is customary?

An honorarium is a monetary gift given by the family to persons who are directly involved in the funeral or memorial service. Such persons commonly include the minister, soloist and or musician. Some churches, clergy and musicians have a set fee while others do not. The customary honorarium for a minister range from \$200 to \$300.00. The customary amount for musicians is \$125 to \$150. In certain churches were Alter servers are used the customary honorarium is \$10.00 per server.

2. How much does Social Security pay?

Social Security provides \$255 to the surviving spouse or dependent child. Under certain circumstances, other benefits may be applicable. You should contact Social Security at 1-800-772-1213 to apply for any benefits.

3. What benefits are veterans entitled to?

Every honorably discharged veteran is entitled to burial in a national cemetery, a flag, a grave marker, and Military Honors at the cemetery. A copy of the veterans discharge papers (DD-214) is required to make the request. There are no monetary benefits for funeral expenses unless the veteran died in a VA facility, was receiving a VA Pension or was receiving VA Disability Payments.

4. How do we order flowers?

The funeral home can provide you with a complete list of local florists and phone numbers with which you may order flowers or your funeral director can order the flowers for you.

5. When will we receive the Certified Death Certificates?

Receiving certified death certificates typically takes about 3 to 4 weeks. If the death was handled by the county Medical Examiner or Coroner, it may be up to 6 months or more before a certified death certificate may be received, depending upon the circumstances surrounding the death.

6. When do we pay the funeral home?

A complete explanation of our payment policy can be found on the third page of this booklet. Should you have any questions concerning our payment policy, please feel free to ask your Funeral Director.

HELPFUL REMINDERS

The following are some of the things that will need to be completed following a death:

- Notify the employer of the deceased and personnel or insurance department.
- File insurance claims Our personnel can assist you with this at NO charge.
- File appropriate health insurance claims Notify them that a death has occurred.
- Notify your home, health, & auto insurance companies Cancel or change as appropriate.
- Northside Chapel will notify Social Security of the death You should contact Social Security about any benefits (1-800-772-1213)
- Contact the financial institutions holding the mortgage on the deceased's home or other outstanding loans.
- Contact banks to cancel checking accounts and safety deposit boxes.
- Transfer assets as appropriate
- Cancel any direct deposit payments that are made in the name of the deceased.
- Contact the Veterans Administration if applicable.
- Cancel credit cards and charge accounts.
- Cancel subscriptions and memberships as applicable.
- Cancel medical coverage and other types of insurance for the deceased.
- Change the beneficiary on insurance policies, retirements accounts, certificates of deposit and savings bonds.
- Change ownership of joint or solely owned stocks and bonds.
- Transfer or close IRA and retirement accounts and other investments managed by a broker.
- Cancel or re-direct the deceased's mail according to specific needs
- Cancel or re-name utility billings
- Cancel any apartment rental agreements of the deceased.
- Check on status of automobile payments and titles.
