The family provides up to 20 photos of their loved one, which are then crafted into a DVD presentation accompanied by music. This 3 to 5 minute DVD uses light, sound, music, and motion to create a powerful, loving tribute that tells the story of a life and imparts loving impressions of the person who has died. This can be shown at visitations, at the service itself or simply as a keepsake. Multiple copies and customized tributes are available at an additional cost.

How to Use This Price List

We've tried to make our options as clear as possible for you. With the exception of our basic service fee, you can pick and choose any items you like to put together a funeral that's right for you. Our services are divided into 7 main categories:

- Primary Services
- Care and Preparation of the Deceased
- Facilities, Staff and Equipment
- Automotive Equipment
- · Burial Merchandise
- Miscellaneous Merchandise and Services
- Simple Services

If you want to put together your own funeral, start with the Primary Services (our basic services fee is mandatory, but everything else is your choice), then add what you like from Care and Preparation of the Deceased, Facilities, Staff, and Equipment, Automotive Equipment, Burial Merchandise, or Miscellaneous Merchandise and Services.

Thank you for choosing Wages & Sons Funeral Home. For over 40 years, our family has provided the highest quality possible in funeral care. We feel it of utmost importance for the families we serve to be well informed. Therefore, we are providing you with this complete listing of all prices and professional services. Should you have any questions about our general price list, please do not hesitate to direct them to any of our staff members.

Statement of funeral goods and services:

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our families. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangement you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Minimum services of the funeral director and staff: \$2395.00

Our fee for the services of the funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to the initial request for service; arrangement conference with the family or responsible party; planning the funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. clergy. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in these charges are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, equipment and inventory costs and governmental compliance (OSHA, ADA, etc.)

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming: \$995.00

Except in certain special cases embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Forwarding remains to another funeral home: \$4455.00

......This charge includes removal of remains, necessary services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, minimum shipping container, and local transportation to the airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding the body.

Receiving remains from another funeral home: \$3145.00

This charge includes removal of remains from airport, temporary shelter of remains, transportation of the remains to the cemetery and necessary services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies.

Cremation: \$450.00

The cremation casket or container that has been selected by the family is placed in to the care of our crematory. Once placed into the cremation chamber, intense heat reduces the cremation casket or container and all contents into small fragments. These cremated remains are then placed in a processor and mechanically reduced in size. The cremated remains are placed into an urn or container that has been selected by the family. Disposition then can be completed according to the family's wishes.

Cremation services:

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes removal of remains, necessary services of staff for authorizations and cremation charge. Our Crematory Requires the Human Remains be placed in a minimum alternative cremation container to enable us to place the remains in to the cremation chamber for cremation. Alternative containers encase the remains and can be made of materials like heavy corrugated cardboard, fiberboard or composition materials.

Non-Ceremonial Cremation without viewing or ceremony......\$2195.00 to \$6085.00

This discounted package includes: Basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary, utility vehicle for death certificate and permits, and crematory fee. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container.

Direct cremation with private family viewing \$3915.00 All services included in direct cremation, as well as the bathing and dressing of the deceased, and 1 hour family viewing. This does not include a container for viewing.

This charge includes removal of remains, services of director and staff, preparation/embalming, dressing and cosmetizing, use of facilities for visitation, chapel service, necessary automotive equipment and cremation charge.
