Embalming ....... \$ 500.00

Embalming is a chemical process that provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. The cleansing and replacement of an accepted "memory picture" is part of the embalming process. This procedure must be completed by licensed embalmer certified by the State of Georgia.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Cremation, intense heat reduces all contents into small fragments. These cremated remains are then placed in a processor and mechanically reduced in size. The cremated remains are then placed into an urn/ container selected by the family or a temporary container provided by the funeral home. The temporary container is a box, made of corrugated fiberboard.
